

SAFETY GUIDELINES


The health and safety of our performers, venue staff, and public patrons is our highest priority.

COVID-19 Protocols

- A designated venue staff member **will be on site enforcing COVID-19 safety protocols, training staff in protocols, and monitoring compliance.**
- **Masks will be required** by all participants, staff, and patrons while on the premises.
- **Contact-free, infrared temperature checks will be required** before participants, staff, and patrons can enter the event premises.
- **COVID-19 related symptom checks will be conducted** before anyone enters the premises.
- **6 foot social distancing will be strictly enforced**, members of the same household being the exception.
- All indoor and outdoor spaces shall have **one directional traffic.**
- **Sanitization hand washing stations** will be placed at various easy access points on the premises.
- The outdoor patio and public **occupancy will be capped to city, county, and state guidelines.**
- **Bathroom facilities will be maintained, cleaned, and sanitized** throughout the event.


Performer Agreement

- **All performers shall wear masks** at all times during their actual performance, except wind/brass players and vocalists.
- **Stage, rehearsal rooms, and other on-site facilities** will be cleaned and sanitized by venue staff prior to participant's arrival.
- **Equipment and instruments** provided on the stage will be sanitized in between sets.
- **Backstage areas and green rooms** will be modified to allow for proper social distancing.
- **Vocalists** will be required to provide their own microphone.
- **Soundcheck and load in times** will be staggered for safe and distanced arrivals.
- Any performer who **exhibits symptoms as defined by the CDC** shall not attend this event.



Stay home if...
